ITEM H. <u>INDIVIDUAL ITEMS/NEW BUSINESS</u>

1. EMERGENCY PURCHASE OF MALWARE BYTES

On January 3, 2018, the City of Farmington Information Technology system was attacked by a "ransom" virus that quickly spread across the City's IT systems causing encryption and widespread computer disruption. The City has invested significant resources in the defense software; even so, this latest virus overcame those defenses. San Juan College is moving rapidly to ensure that all potential vulnerabilities are shored-up against this new threat. In that vein, College Leadership recommends the immediate purchase and installation of MalwareBytes Endpoint Protection. The cost of a 3-year license and the quick start service will not exceed \$110,000 plus applicable gross receipts taxes.

Mr. Chance moved and Dr. Pope seconded the motion to approve the emergency purchase of MalwareBytes Endpoint Protection under a 3-year license for a cost not to exceed \$110,000 plus applicable gross receipts taxes. **MOTION CARRIED** by unanimous voice vote.
