- 2. Review of January 2020 Financial Report

Executive Vice President Edward DesPlas reviewed the January 2020 Operating Budget Report from the Financial Statements. Expenditures lag slightly behind percent-of-fiscal year elapsed. Oil & Gas Production Tax Revenue is significantly and dramatically missing its target. This will need to be adjusted in the year-end budget revision.

3. Future Board Meetings: Recommendations on Remote IT Support and SQL Migration Support

Trustees were advised that proposals for Remote IT Support were opened. If evaluations go rapidly, SJC will have a recommendation for award at the April 7th Board meeting. Trustees were also advised that SJC expects to release the Request for Proposals (RFP) for third-party support of our SQL Migration project on March 8th.

4. Budget and Financial Outlook

Edward DesPlas presented on the Budget and Financial Outlook for FY 2021. Bottom line is that the budget is flat going from FY2020 to FY2021.

5. New Programs

Two potential new programs were shared with the Trustees: <u>Online Marketing</u> presented by Annette Abend and <u>Drones</u> presented by Brian Seavey.

6. Change of May Board Meeting Date

Dates were discussed and April 28th was determined to be the date for the May meeting.

7. New Officers for Board

Trustees discussed appointments to be approved during the Board meeting.

8. Student Housing Update

Edward DesPlas updated the Trustees on the progress toward Student Housing. The design concept has shifted from apartment style units to suite style units. The shift in design is aimed toward creating and sustaining connections with the resident students.

9. Caring Campus Update

Dr. Appleman was unable to show his power point due to time constraints, but did inform the Trustees about SJC's emerging Caring Communities initiative which is an effort to enhance sustainable connections with our students.
