#### Health Sciences Clinic Requirement Update

At the San Juan College School of Health Sciences, we are committed to the well-being of our community, including our most vulnerable populations. In order to meet clinical requirements to successfully complete our programs, proof of vaccinations, including the COVID 19 vaccination may be required.

The San Juan College Dental Hygiene Program requires all students to be vaccinated against Hepatitis B. A quantitative titer will confirm immunity and all students must show evidence of immunity before starting clinicals. This process can take up to 6 months, and should be started as soon as possible.

- Critical Thinking
- Ethical Decision Making
- Writing Skill
  - o Organization of Content
  - Vocabulary and Sentence Fluency
  - Elaboration of Ideas

Applicants are strongly discouraged from using AI during the writing process of their Essays for Application and should use AI tools with extreme caution. The insights and reflections presented in the Essays must be the applicants own and should be grounded in specific real-world examples of their experiences and accomplishments. The final content of the Essays must be the applicants own work and reflect their personal voice and original ideas. The use of AI should not replace or obscure the applicant's authentic reflection within their Essays.

For the purposes of this policy, AI tools include but are not limited to large language models, text generators, automated writing assistants, and any software that can produce human-like text or analysis based on prompts or inputs.

While AI use is generally discouraged, limited use may be permitted for basic grammar and spelling checks and formatting assistance. AI tools must not be used for generating original content, ideas, or reflections, rewriting or paraphrasing the applicants work, or analyzing or interpreting the applicants' experiences or accomplishments.

Violation of this policy may result in the rejection of the application.

#### • ATDH Information

- Read the complete <u>ATDH Candidate Guide</u> before submitting your ATDH application. The Candidate Guide can be found at <u>https://www.ada.org/education/testing/exams/admission-test-for-dental-hygiene-atdh</u>. This guide provides important information about application and testing procedures, examination content, fees, etc.
- Start by obtaining a new <u>DENTPIN</u>. Your DENTPIN is the unique identifier for all your dental testing needs.
- Complete the ATDH application and schedule an exam at one of the ATDH Test Centers. Students will need to submit their application 2 to 3 months before they intend to take the exam.
- Students will need to send their ATDH scores directly to the San Juan College Registration and Records Department at <u>records@sanjuancollege.edu</u>.
- Students will need to include a copy of their ATDH scores with their Dental Hygiene Program Application.
- The San Juan College Testing Center will administer the ATDH on Fridays and Saturdays along with some Thursdays, except for the SJC holidays and graduation.
- The ATDH will be available year-round, effective September 1, 2023.
