Target Institution: University of Cincinnati / College of Allied Health Sciences
Degree/Program: Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy (Online)

Introduction: This agreement details the program to program articulation from the San Juan College Associate of Applied Science in Respiratory Care to the Bachelor of Science degree program in Respiratory Therapy at the College of Allied Health Sciences of the University of Cincinnati. Students who have successfully completed the Associate of Science In Respiratory Therapy at San Juan College have satisfied the University of Cincinnati General Education requirement.

A maximum of 70 credits from the San Juan College Respiratory Therapy program, as found in Appendix A, will be transferred from San Juan College to UC and applied toward the 120 semester hours required for the Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy. **If the curriculum is 65-69 semester-credits, students will take UC's Respiratory Therapy Targeted Open Online Course, offered tuition free, to help meet the required 120 semester hours for the Bachelor of Science degree in Respiratory Therapy.*

Articulation Overview: Graduates from San Juan College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the College of Allied Health Sciences will enter the third year of the baccalaureate Respiratory Therapy program. Student's associate degree will transfer in its entirety as block credit.

Admission Criteria: Please note: completing the courses in the appendix does not guarantee admission to the Bachelor of Science in Respiratory Therapy program.

The successful candidate must:

- Hold an A.S. or A.A.S. degree from a CoARC accredited Respiratory Care/Respiratory Therapy program in a regionally accredited institution
- Be credentialed as a Certified Respiratory Therapist (CRT) by the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC)
- Be Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT) eligible
- Complete a UC application
- Complete a program application
- Submit official transcripts from all schools attended
- Submit an application fee: \$50
- Submit a matriculation fee: \$100

Minimum GPA: 2.5

Admission Period: San Juan College students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement, i.e. between July 2018 and July 2021.

Agreement End Date: November 2021

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

San Juan College and the UC College of Allied Health Sciences agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The deans of both colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

San Juan College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
